

Today's Theme: God's Creation

Today's Lesson: Genesis 1 - 2

Script:

Do you know who made the sun? The sky? The water and trees? God did! God made everything in our wonderful world!

In the beginning, there were no tall trees, no flowers or sunshine. There were no animal and no people! Only darkness. Nothing! But there was God. He was always there. And He created the world.

Show card #1

First, God said, "Let there be light." And just like that – there was light! God called the light "day." God made the daytime for working and playing.

God made our world dark part of the time. God called the quiet dark "night." Nighttime is the perfect time for sleeping.

Next God made the sky. He put this beautiful sky up, up, up high. He made it bright and blue. God

made lots of fluffy, puffy white clouds to float in the beautiful blue sky.

Show card #2

Next, God took all the water and put some here and some there until the world had oceans, lakes and rivers full of water. And between the water was dry land. God made tall, tall mountains, little round hills and low flat places, too.

Show card #3

God said, “Let grass and trees and flowers grow.” And they did! Just like that! Soft green grass, tall trees, tiny plants, fruit trees and berry bushes, vegetables and flower all began to grow. But that’s not all God made!

Show card #4

God made special lights – the bright warm sun to shine in the daytime and the moon and stars to shine at night.

Show card #5

But God's world was still very quiet. The lakes, rivers and oceans were empty! So, God said, "Let the water be full of fish!" And there were fish! Big fish and whales and dolphins jumped and swam in the ocean. God made gray fish and green fish. Fish that looked like stars and tiny fish that had heads that looked like horses! God made crabs that crawled and clams that dug into the sand.

Show card #6

Then God looked at the big beautiful sky. There was nothing but clouds! So, God said, "Let birds fly in the sky." Soon, blue birds and yellow birds, big birds and small flew in the sky. They made nests in the trees. Eagles flew high and chickens scratched the ground.

Show card #7

But the rest of the land was still very empty. So God said, "Let there be all kinds of animals!" And just as God said, there were animals everywhere!

**Horses and zebras, monkeys, cows, goats, sheep.
Any kind of animal you could think of, God made.**

Show card #8

**God looked at all the fish and birds and animals He
had made. God said, "It is good."**

**But there was no one in the world for God to talk
with. And there was no one in the world to help
take care of what God had made.**

Show card #9

**Then God made someone to talk to. He made a
person. This person was a man. God named the
man Adam.**

Show card #10

**God told Adam to take care of everything He had
made. God also told Adam to give names to all the
animals. So, Adam gave a name to each one.**

**Adam was happy with the animals and the trees
and the flowers. But he was all alone. There were
no other people like you and me. God knew that
Adam needed someone to love. Adam also needed**

help to take care of the beautiful world God had made.

Show card #11

So, God made a woman. Adam called her Eve. God said to Adam and Eve, “Take care of the animals that I made. Use the plants for your food.” So, they ate the tasty fruit that grew on the trees. And every day God was with Adam and Eve. Adam and Eve talked to God. God loved them very much. And Adam and Eve loved God.

God made everything! He thought to made everything we could possibly need. And just like He made Adam and Eve, He made you and me! We can be so thankful to God for making us and everything around us.
