ECCLESIASTES: Wisdom for Life

Ecclesiastes 3:1-15 - Seasons Change; God Remains - 02.22.2026

1. Is there anything specific from this message that the Lord has impressed upon your heart?
If so, what is it & how do you feel the Lord calling you to respond?
2. Our text for our message was Ecclesiastes 3:1-15; take a moment to read these verses.
As you consider what's written in verses 1-8, how have you experienced these different seasons in your own life?
Have you ever taken the wrong action in one of the seasons/times where you should have taken the other action listed?
What was the outcome of your actions at that particular time, and how has God used that experience in your life?
What do you think Solomon was trying to show his readers (& us) by sharing all of these examples of different times/seasons?
3. How does the question presented in verse 9 (& what follows) relate to what was written in the previous 8 verses of chapter 3?
Do you see any kind of connection between the changing times/seasons and everything written in verses 9-15?
How does is sermon title, "Seasons Change; God Remains" reflected in these verses?
How does God's consistency (i.e. faithfulness) help us to navigate the changing seasons of our lives?
4. As you consider verse 11, where have you seen beauty in something that at another time might be not be viewed as "beautiful"?
Consider this: "he has put eternity into man's heart, yet so that he cannot find out what God has done from beginning to the end."
Where have you seen/experienced this in your own life and where have you observed it in humanity all around you?
How does it impact you to know that God has put eternity in our hearts yet even still we can't fully grasp His eternity?
5. Are there specific situations in your life that you've been trying to hold on to or control with that are actually beyond your control?
How does resting in God's sovereignty as seen here enable us to find pleasure in food, drink, & toil in life rather than despair?
6. Below are the "Today's Takeaways" from this sermon; do any of these particularly encourage, convict, & challenge you? If so, how?
In a post-fall world, we all seek autonomy & control!
God is sovereign & much of life is beyond our grip!
Seasons change; the Lord remains the same forever!
We ought to trust our faithful God in every season!
God created us all with an inward eternal yearning!
We can't understand it, so we rely on our Creator!
